This instrument is the largest of all Knight models. The Knight Special Action is standard fitment and because of the full size frame or plate the standard key is incorporated. Many musicians have expressed the opinion that the K.10 is equal in tone to any 5 ft. grand piano. The resonant bass and balanced treble make the instrument ideally suitable for use in larger homes, schools, or studios. Illustrated in mahogany, satin.

Internally and performance-wise the Slimline is the regular Knight model but the instrument has been styled to conform with contemporary Scandinavian home furnishings. This styling creates the apparent reduction in depth. This new design was developed at the request of customers in several overseas countries and in the light of its popularity we are indebted to our friends for their suggestions and interest. The most popular finish is the oiled teak shown.

Originally styled for the American market this model has proved to be the best selling Knight piano in the United States. Like Model K.10 the instrument has a Direct Blow Action and the slightly smaller frame or plate size is made possible by fitting the Knight Step Down Key. Round and tapered leg models have the diamond design desk whilst softened curves complement the French Provincial legs. Finish shown is European cherry.
